Membership Process

1. Applicant must have NJ Firearms ID. Proof of application will serve as provisional status: final membership when NJFID received. Active and retired law enforcement personnel are exempt from this requirement. Firearms ID's from other states will be honored if the applicant is not a New Jersey resident.
2. Applicant should sign a waiver if one is not already on file.
3. These forms are in range officer locker #2.
4. Applicant's name to go on handwritten list of prospective members at the range log table upon receipt of completed application. This formalizes their status and gives members a chance to review the list for comments in case they know or know of the applicant.
5. Until membership approval, prospective member shoots at \$15 guest fee. Do not accept membership payment at this point.
6. Encourage the applicant to try different nights to meet a cross section of members and range officers. Input to be sought from members and range officers regarding applicant's safety and gun handling.
7. Background check to be performed.
8. At next executive or regular meeting, applicant's status to be reviewed, hearing background check and input from members and range officers.
9. Upon acceptance, a letter with a prorated bill to be mailed to the applicant. Membership runs to end of current year. Membership rejection will result in an appropriate letter.
10. Upon receiving payment, a membership card to be sent.
11. NRA membership is encouraged but not required.
