

PASJ WINTER BULLSEYE LEAGUE

Dates: February 1, 2004 to April 30, 2004.

Type of League: Postal.

Fee: \$25.00 – Due with application.

Deadline for Entry: February 29, 2004.

Total Matches: 16 (8 National Match & 8 International.)

Caliber: 22 – NRA Pistol rules apply.

Match Course/Times/Targets: All matches fired at 25 yards.

National Match (Short Course) – 30 Rounds – NRA Pistol Rules.			
	Rounds	Target	Time
Slow Fire	10	B16	1 Minute per shot.
Timed Fire	10	B9	20 Seconds per 5 shot string.
Rapid Fire	10	B9	10 Seconds per 5 shot string.

International Pistol Course – 30 Rounds – NRA International Rules.			
	Rounds	Target	Time
Slow Fire	10	B19	150 Seconds per 5 shot string.
Timed Fire	10	B19	20 Seconds per 5 shot string.
Rapid Fire	10	B19	10 Seconds per 5 shot string.

Verification: All targets MUST BE witnessed and signed by 2 current NRA members (neither being the shooter). The shooter must SIGN/ DATE their target. Each shooter must include their NRA member number.

Deadline for Submission: ALL targets and cards must be postmarked by May 8, 2004.

Classifications: Shooters not classified by NRA will shoot as in the unclassified category.

Ties: All ties will be notified and resolved during the month of May 2004.

Awards: Medals will be given in each category by June 30, 2004. All standings will be posted at www.pasj.com. Mailed standings available on request. In the event there is only 1 shooter in a category, they will be moved up to the next higher category (for awards ONLY). This does not apply to unclassified shooters.

Challenges and Protests: The PASJ will elect a scoring committee on March 1, 2004. This committee will be responsible for all target challenges. All decisions will be final. Members of the scoring committee must abstain in the event they are involved in the challenge. Protest will be handled according to NRA Rule 16.
