RANGE RULES

- 1) SAFETY, SAFETY
- 2) NO firing without a range officer present.
- All persons on the range MUST sign in; all shooters must produce a current membership card or pay guest fee prior to shooting.
- 4) No drinking of alcoholic beverages on the range.
- All "Guest" and "NEW" members will be evaluated and observed by a range officer prior to shooting.
- Shatter resistant eye protection and ear protection (at least 25 decibels) **MUST** be worn **BY ALL** persons on the range.
- 7) ALL firing MUST be done from the booths. Exceptions to this are range-sponsored events, retired police officer qualifications and departmental qualifications.
- 8) Holsters may not be worn except for range-sponsored events, retired police officer qualifications, department qualifications and the range officer on duty.
- 9) FIREARMS may be loaded in the booths ONLY.
- **10) RED FLASHING LIGHTS -** mean cease-fire, open action, make firearms safe, wait for instructions.
- 11) Only ONE (1) person shooting in a booth at one time.
- **12)** Magnum or high-powered center fire cartridges ARE NOT permitted. All firearms and calibers are subject to range officer approval.
- 13) NO FULLY AUTOMATIC FIREARMS PERMITTED!!!!!!
- **14)** All brass must be picked up at the end of shooting.
- **15)** Shotguns are permitted only for police qualification.
- 16) No children under the age of twelve (12) are permitted to shoot. Children twelve (12) through seventeen (17) must be supervised one on one by a range officer or an adult member.
- 17) ALL persons on the range MUST act in a SAFE and Responsible manner at ALL TIMES!!!!
- 18) THE RANGE OFFICER IS IN CHARGE AT ALL TIMES!!!!!
 HIS/HER WORD IS LAW!!!!!!
- **19)** NO SMOKING on the firing line or in the meeting room.
- **20)** No active or retired police officer qualifications during regular range hours.
- 21) Loaded firearms may not be brought into the range except by law enforcement personnel.
